<p>Membership Requirements</p>	<p>At close of entries, all Australian competitors must be a full financial member of their relevant State Association and an affiliated club. (Inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their state association).</p> <p>The membership must be valid during the full competition period.</p> <p>All Aussie Skate™ entrants must also be registered with ISA Aussie Skate™ and currently enrolled in Aussie Skate™</p> <p>Overseas entrants must be financial members of an ISU member skating organisation and/or its affiliates, as required by their national organization; the membership must be valid during the full competition period.</p>
<p>Insurance/Liability</p>	<p>All members of State Associations are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. This policy includes Sport Accident cover.</p> <p>ISA & Ice Skating Victoria assume no responsibility for other persons in connection with this event.</p> <p>ISA recommends that any person travelling to an interstate event consider personal travel insurance.</p>
<p>Eligibility to Compete</p>	<p>Skaters Preliminary and above must have passed the relevant ISA test level at the close of entries.</p> <p>Competitors in Aussie Skate™ divisions must compete at the highest test level passed by the competition closing date and cannot enter a level lower than that which they have previously competed.</p> <p>Skaters who have passed the ISA Preliminary Test at close of entries are not permitted to compete at Aussie Skate™ level.</p>
<p>Practice Sessions</p>	<p>There will be official practices in the morning of the event for IJS events only. There will be no official practices for Aussie Skate events. Practice Schedules will be published with the event Schedule.</p>

<p>Entry Process and Eligibility to Compete</p>	<p>Online entry submitted directly to ISV by competitors ISV will provide a list of competitors to the state associations within (2) two days of close of entries. State Associations will confirm to ISV as soon as possible thereafter, the skaters' eligibility to compete as well as membership status of both club and state.</p> <p>PPC and Music must be submitted with the entry.</p>
<p>Conditions for Online Entry</p>	<p>All Interstate competitors must notify their relevant state association of their entry submission prior to entering.</p> <p>All state associations will be asked to confirm that entrants are full financial</p>
