PERMISSION FOR ICE SHOW PARTICIPATION AND SANCTION

Skaters wishing to participate in ice shows/exhibitions, will seek permission from their State Body that they are a Member of. In granting permission, the State Body will remind their member of ISU Rule 102. When known, the skater will inform the State Body of any remuneration or benefits received, or, at the State Body's discretion, payments to the skaters may be made through the State body. At the State bodies discretion, the organiser of the ice shows may make the application to the State Body on behalf of the skaters. Organisers of ice shows/exhibitions that wish to include members will write to State bodies requesting the ice shows/exhibition be sanctioned by the State Body.

Any approval/sanctioning by a State body or ISU member will be deemed to be approved/sanctioned by ISA.

States are to report quarterly to ISA advising the ice shows/exhibitions sanctioned, members approved to take part and the remuneration received.
