



ISV Computer System Setup Guide

1. Set Up tables
2. Lay out the extension cords, and power boards.
 - 1x 6 socket board near Expert
 - 1x 6 socket board at end of judges
 - Extension cords to connect
3. Lay out the cable trunk (network and laptop power)
4. Connect corresponding power supplies at the far end (Toshiba laptops only)
5. Connect the Dell power supplies to the power board near the Expert
6. Setup the routers (wireless & wired), with power supplies
7. Place the Video Converter & Video Splitter with the routers
8. Lay out Firewire cables, one for each of the Dells (small end to laptop, large end into video splitter)
9. Plug in the 2m Firewire cable with 2 large ends between the Video Converter and Video Splitter
10. Run the composite video cable from the Video Converter to the video camera
11. Setup printer, and external monitor (if there will be a large Technical panel)
12. Lay down all laptops
13. Connect Ethernet and power to laptops (DO NOT PLUG IN FIREWIRE)
14. Connect VGA cable from monitor to Expert
15. Power on the computers
 - Expert, Judges & Cutter all at once
 - Once Expert is loaded, boot up ISUCalcFS
16. In each Judge interface select the corresponding GREEN judge number
17. In Expert click MAIN (it will go green)
18. All Judges should now be green
19. Load up the Event in ISUCalcFS (all connections should now be green in Expert)
20. Connect mice, and place mouse pads
21. In ScoreDP (scoreboard software on ISUCalcFS), click display, special or Ident, to confirm connection. You should see the web browser display this.
22. Boot up Score Board laptop
23. Make sure it is connected to the wireless
24. Load the scoreboard shortcut (desktop)
25. Connect to VGA cable in announcers box
26. On Icehouse AV tablet select "North Wall", "Hockey", "Computer" under the rink 1 settings. Make sure screen is displaying correctly.
27. Return to system and start to add judge data if not already added
