The Net Profit for the period was a loss of \$13,837. However, due to the timing of Victorian State Championships – the 2018 income fell pre-October 2018 and the expenses post October 2018. This creates an inaccurate reflection of the activity for the period and the attached Profit & Loss has been adjusted to resolve this. The overall event based Net Profit for the period was \$79.

Moving forward, this inaccurate reflection will be a non-issue as we have adjusted the financial year to better reflect our skating year.

Report on the financial report
