Membership Requirements	<p>At close of entries, all Australian competitors must be a full financial member of their relevant State Association and an affiliated club. (Inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their state association).</p> <p>The membership must be valid during the full competition period.</p> <p>Overseas entrants must be financial members of an ISU member skating organisation and/or its affiliates, as required by their national organization; the membership must be valid during the full competition period.</p>
Insurance/Liability	<p>All members of Australian State Associations are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. This policy includes Sport Accident cover.</p> <p>ISA & Ice Skating Victoria assume no responsibility for other persons in connection with this event.</p> <p>ISA recommends that any person travelling to an interstate / overseas event consider personal travel insurance.</p>
Eligibility to Compete	<p>There are no test requirements for this event. However Australian entries should abide by ISA adult requirements to ensure the correct division. International competitors should also be mindful of their skill level when entering the correct division.</p>
Practice Sessions	<p>There will be official practices in the mornings of the events. Practice Schedules will be published with the event Schedule.</p> <p>There will also be unofficial practice ice available on Friday 9th February 4-5pm Click here to book the 4pm Session 5-6pm Click here to book the 5pm Session</p>

Entry Process and Eligibility to Compete	<p>Online entry submitted directly to ISV by competitors</p> <p>PPC and Music must be submitted with the entry – entry will not be able to be completed without it.</p> <p>Each skater in an event will need to register eg dance, pairs, duos and groups however only 1 copy of the music needs to be lodged.</p>

Artistic Duos and Trios	Artistic Duos and Trios are as per SECTION 9 – ARTISTIC COMPETITIONS June 2022
Pewter Single Free Skating	<p>A well-balanced Pewter program must show the skater's ability to use edges, turns and other skating movements to interpret music. No specific jumps are required.</p> <p>There are 2 required elements.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. A maximum of one (1) spin element. Only two foot spins are permitted b. A maximum of one (1) choreographed step sequence, (straight line, circular or serpentine) or choreographed spiral sequence. This should cover at least a third of the ice surface. Choreographed spirals must contain at least one spiral position held for 3 seconds c. Jumps are optional. These are restricted to ½ revolution jumps. <p>For example. Waltz jump, half flip, half loop.</p> <p>VOCAL MUSIC MAY BE USED</p> <p>The maximum time is 1 minute and 40 seconds, but may be less. The points for each Program Component are multiplied by a factor of 1.6.</p>

Copper Dance	Pattern Dances: Canasta Tango (2 sequences) Free Dance: Requirements: A well-balanced program. Music Length – 1 minute 30 seconds or less. One (1) Dance Spin - Spin or Combination Spin One (1) Step Sequence – half the rink One (1) Synchronized Twizzle in each direction.
