<b>Membership Requirements</b>	<p>At close of entries, all Australian competitors must be a full financial member of their relevant ISA Member and an affiliated club. (Inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their state association).</p> <p>The membership must be valid during the full competition period.</p> <p>Overseas entrants must be financial members of an ISU member skating organisation and/or its affiliates, as required by their national organization; the membership must be valid during the full competition period.</p>
<b>Insurance/Liability</b>	<p>All members of Australian State Associations are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. This policy includes Sport Accident cover.</p> <p>ISA &amp; Ice Skating Victoria assume no responsibility for other persons in connection with this event.</p> <p>ISA recommends that any person travelling to an interstate / overseas event consider personal travel insurance.</p>
<b>Eligibility to Compete</b>	<p>There are no test requirements for this event. However Australian entries should abide by ISA adult requirements to ensure the correct division.</p> <p>International competitors should also be mindful of their skill level when entering the correct division.</p>
<b>Practice Sessions</b>	<p>There will be official practices on the mornings of the events. Practice Schedules will be published with the event Schedule.</p> <p>There will also be unofficial practice ice available on Friday 6<sup>th</sup> February at 4-5pm and 5-6pm and sessions can be booked <a href="#">here via the ISV website</a>.</p>
