	All Aussie Skate entrants must also be registered with ISA Aussie Skate and currently enrolled in Aussie Skate	
	Failure to comply with membership requirements will result in withdrawal from the event.	
	Overseas entrants must be financial members of an ISU member skating organisation and/or its affiliates, as required by their national organization; the membership must be valid during the full competition period.	
Insurance/Liability	All members of State Associations are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. This policy includes Sport Accident cover.

Eligibility to Compete	Skaters Preliminary and above must have passed the relevant test level/s at the close of entries. Entry will be based on level at close of entries.
