Results	• The IJS (ISU Judging System) will be used for all Categories with Open Marking for all categories. • Results displayed or announced will remain provisional until certified by the segment Referee and Technical Controller on the official result form. • VFSC categories will have results published live on the web. SCT results may be uploaded post event.
Membership Requirements	At close of entries, all Australian competitors must be a full financial member of their ISA Member and an affiliated club (Inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their ISA Member). Membership must be valid during the full competition period. Overseas entrants must be financial members of an ISU Member skating organisation and/or its affiliates, as required by their national organization; the membership must be valid during the full competition period.
Insurance/Liability	All members of an ISA Member are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. This policy includes Sport Accident cover. ISA and Ice Skating Victoria assume no responsibility for other persons in connection with this event. ISA recommends that any person travelling to an interstate event consider personal travel insurance.
Eligibility to Compete	At close of entries the skater must 1. Be a current financial member of an ISA Member 2. Have passed the relevant ISA Technical and Pattern Skills Test level as per the applicable ISA By-Laws 3. Be age eligible for the relevant category in Basic Novice to Senior as per By-Law Section 3 (Single and Pair Skating) Skaters who do not meet the applicable eligibility requirements at the close of entries will not be registered for the event or, where already registered, will be withdrawn from the event. ISA Members will confirm to ISV, as soon as practicable thereafter, each skater's eligibility, including age, relevant test level and membership status with both the ISA Member and an affiliated Club, as at the close of entries.

Practice Sessions	Official practice sessions will be offered as per the event schedule for: • IJS Singles Advanced Novice - Senior. • IJS Singles Adult Gold - Elite Masters. • IJS Solo Dance (SID) Advanced Novice - Senior. • IJS Synchro Basic Novice - Adults. There will be no official practice below Advanced Novice and Adult Gold in any discipline. Practice Schedules will be published with the event Schedule.
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COMPETITION ENTRY DETAILS	
Entry Process and Eligibility to Compete	Online entry submitted directly to ISV by competitors ISV will provide a list of competitors to the ISA Members within (2) two days of close of entries. ISA Members will confirm to ISV as soon as possible thereafter, the skaters' eligibility to compete as well as membership status of both ISA Member and affiliated Club. PPC and Music must be submitted with the entry.
Conditions for Online Entry	All ISA competitors (if not a member of Ice Skating Victoria) must notify their relevant ISA Member of their entry submission prior to entering. All ISA Members will be asked to confirm that entrants are full financial members in good standing, of both the ISA Member and an affiliated club.
Payment Process	Payments for this event are made through the online registration process. Refer to the ISV website: http://iceskatingvictoria.org.au/events/vic/ for information and links.
Entry Conditions	Entries will not be considered complete unless accompanied by: - o Full Payment, paid on entry - o Music File – electronically submitted on entry with correct file naming protocol - o <u>Completed and up to date Planned Program Content sheet (PPC)</u> for all IJS-level programs to be received on entry. Incomplete entries may be disallowed at the discretion of the ISV LOC and Board. * Late entries will only be accepted at the sole discretion of the ISV Board. A further \$50 fee will be applied if the late entry is accepted.
Withdrawals	Refunds only permitted with a medical certificate provided <u>prior to the event date</u>. A 20% administration fee to cover costs will be deducted from the refund.

Music Provision and File Naming	Online upload: All competitors will submit a copy of their music electronically via the upload link during registration. All files must be submitted in the following format: mP3 Provided at Registration: Clearly named USB Drive All competitors will have on hand at the event a named back-up copy of their music on USB. One music file per USB. (Music on mobile phones WILL NOT be accepted. Awards/Trophies	Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded to the first, second and third placed competitors in all VFSC categories. Participants from other ISA members, who place in any of the three (3) positions at VFSC event, will be given appropriate medals, in addition to the medals awarded to the three highest-placed ISV competitors. A Perpetual Trophy and 'Keep Cup' will be presented to the ISV State Champion in the Basic Novice to Senior categories.
ISV President's Cup 2026	Eligibility Criteria - AFSC age eligible categories (Advanced Novice to Senior) in Singles, Solo Dance, Dance Teams and Pairs Teams. Judging Criteria - Awarded annually to the "Best Performance at the Victorian Figure Skating Championships" as determined by the ISV President (from time to time). A Perpetual Trophy and 'Keep Cup' will be presented to the nominated recipient.
